




Our Learning Vision

Our vision is to provide a learning environment where all students can learn.

Our iLearning Vision

By giving our students more *creative freedom* and *ownership* of their learning and by bringing parents/carers into a *closer relationship* with the teaching and learning at the school, we pledge to build strong skills in our students which are highly relevant to the digital world we are living in.

The best lesson, the best learning may involve a lot, a little or no iPad.

Choice

- School-owned device: school owns and controls the devices. They are bookable and the teacher decides when they are used
- BYOD: Devices chosen by parent. All types of devices can be used. Student owns device.
- School purchase scheme: School negotiates package via a scheme. School provides support and training for the device. Student owns device.

iPad v Other Tablets Not about the hardware. About the learning


- Heavily involved in education over the past 25 years
- 900,000 apps of which 95,000 are specifically education focussed and can extend rich, deep and extensive learning
- Apple build their own hardware and software and they are more rigorous in the checks that an app has to go through before it's allowed on the App-Store-robust and safe

iPad v Other Tablets Not about the hardware. About the learning

- Content delivery is key-Apple have a content delivery system specifically for education; iTunes U. It allows students to download course notes, course materials, recordings digitally. As well as annotate materials, textbooks purchased via Apple, iTunes store, create own interactive books...
- Educational support-Apple Distinguished Educators
