Revised new term arrangements

Last night's announcement by the Education Minister means that our plans for all students returning to school this term will have to change.

The revised arrangements will mean that:

- The initial period of distance learning will be extended until **Friday 15th January.**
- School will be open to children in Year 7 and Year 8 of critical key workers who have contacted the school in the set timeframe to request support for childcare. Similarly, school will be open to pupils who have arranged support via Miss Jones, Head of Inclusion. Please contact Miss Jones directly if you have any questions. djones2@sjhs.newport.sch.uk
- Students who have scheduled public examinations and formal assessments during this time will still be able to travel to school to complete these and then depart. Mrs Morgan, Deputy Headteacher, will contact the relevant students affected by this during the next few days.
