**Dear Parents and Carers** 

Re: Updated information regarding a positive PCR test result in Year 11

As you know, I made contact with you yesterday to make you aware of the positive lateral flow test result for one of our pupils in Year 11 and the subsequent requirement for the year group to self-isolate whilst we awaited the result from the follow up PCR test. Having taken the follow up PCR test, I can now confirm that the pupil in Year 11 has in fact tested positive for Covid-19.

Therefore, in line with guidance from Welsh Government, Environmental Health and Newport City Council, Year 11 will be required to self-isolate for a period of ten days. The pupil in question was in school on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April, which means that the period of self-isolation will be up to, and including Monday 10<sup>th</sup> May, with a return to school date of Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> May.

Throughout this period of self-isolation, your child's lessons will continue as live lessons remotely on Teams, assessments can continue but your teacher will confirm this with you.

Please see the end of this letter for a copy of your child's timetable.

Whilst this remains a challenging time for all of us, this measure has to be taken in order to comply with guidance and continue to work to suppress the opportunity for the virus to spread, but we will continue to do all that we can to support your child over the next week. Please reassure yourselves and your child that this is the case and if there is anything you need, please do not hesitate to get in touch.

If your child displays any Covid-19 symptoms:

- A new continuous cough and/or
- High temperature (37.8oC or above) and/or
- Loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell
