We will be using an appointment system for parents to book a video call with classroom teachers. In this session the classroom teacher will discuss with you how your child has progressed in their subject, their strengths, areas for development and attitude to learning.

Timings

Meeting times are restricted to <u>5</u> minutes only, there will be a countdown at the top of the screen, when this reaches 0 the meeting will automatically end. This is important as parents will be waiting for their meeting in a virtual lobby. If there are discussion points that will take longer, then a follow up telephone conversation can be arranged.

Format

We hope that these meetings allow you to meet your child's classroom teachers properly. We are aware that this has not been possible for many of you. Your child's classroom teacher will discuss how they have progressed, their strengths, areas for development and attitude to learning. Parents are also encouraged to share anything that they feel the teacher should know. If you have a specific query please note this when making your booking before <u>Wednesday 16th March 2021</u>. The classroom teacher will endeavour to provide you with an answer during your session, arrange to contact you at a later date or arrange another meeting if required.
