# Do you know your personal brand?


Q. Ask two people what they notice about your personality

Q. What type of personal branding would impress?




#### REFLECT HONESTLY

In other words what qualities or personality traits come to mind when you see their face.



You will be given a voting form.


Select ONLY ONE person.
