

Be Safe

Know the law:

- Possession of an offensive weapon in a public place
- Under section 1 of the Prevention of Crime Act 1953 it is an offence for any person to have an "offensive weapon" with them in any public place without "lawful authority" or "reasonable excuse".
- Action: Criminal conviction





- Possession of an offensive weapon or bladed article on school premises
- Under section 139A of the Criminal Justice Act 1988 it is an offence for a person to have a knife with him/her on school premises
- Action: Permanent exclusion and criminal conviction

Know the facts of knife crime

It's a criminal offence to:

- Carry a knife exceeding 3 inches (7.6cm) in public without a valid reason
- Carry any form of knife if you're less than 18 years old
- Sell a knife to anyone under the age of 18
- Threaten or hurt someone with a knife
- Carry any sharp instrument that is used in a threatening way (e.g. a screwdriver) as these are 'offensive weapons'.



Know the risk and consequences;

- The effects of knife crime aren't always what you think of first
- You will receive a minimum prison sentence of up to four years
- Impact on family/loved ones?
- If you get convicted for a knife crime you'll have a criminal record which can affect future employment prospects
- Lots of countries don't let people in who have criminal records eg USA, Australia, New Zealand, Singapore and the law is changing for the UK too.


