PREVENT

- PREVENT is part of the UK government's Counter Terrorism and Security Act 2015.
- The aim of PREVENT is to reduce the threat from terrorism or extremism by stopping people becoming part of terrorist or extremist groups or taking part in activity.
- Everyone should be aware of this for their own and others' safety.





PREVENT

- The 3 main aims of PREVENT are;
- To challenge the ideology or thinking behind terrorism/extremism and those who support it
- To protect those who may be vulnerable
- To support institutions where there may be a risk of radicalisation eg schools, colleges, universities, prisons, religious places.

PREVENT

- PREVENT is not about spying on people or intruding into private family life. PREVENT is about identifying worrying behaviours/language, know how to refer or report those at risk of radicalisation and then provide the appropriate support, intervention or help.
