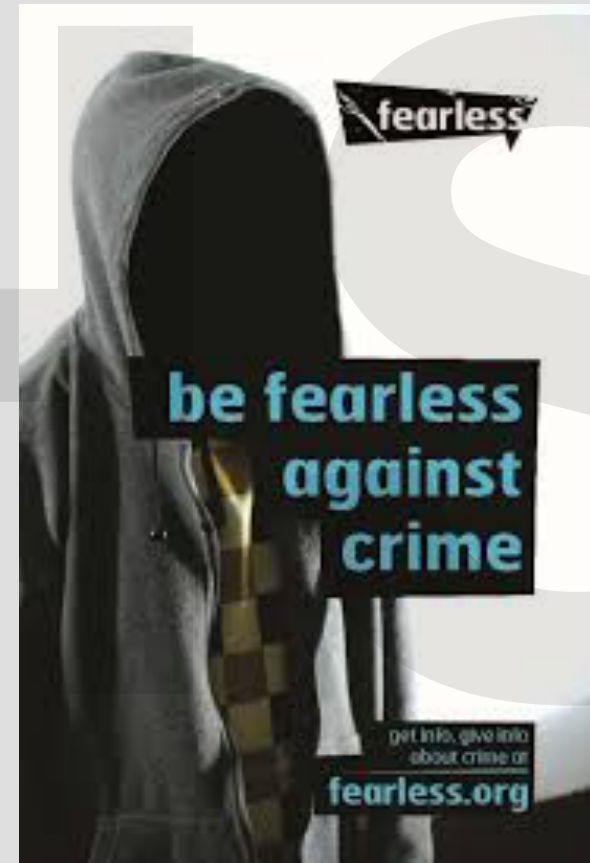

- Q. What is Crimestoppers?
- Crimestoppers is a registered **charity** working to help solve crimes
- They provide the **24/7** phone line **0800 555 111** and website www.crimestoppers-uk.org for people who don't want to go to the police to report a crime
- Individuals can contact **anonymously** to give information
- Not part of the Police
- Not a replacement for 999 or 101
- Only collect information on crime, that's ANY crime.
- Some crimes will have a **reward** offered for the information you give

- They experience higher rates of crime and because of this criminal activity becomes **'the norm'**
- They do not **understand** what a crime is?
- They do not understand that they have become a **victim** of crime
- They **fear** the repercussions of reporting and being branded a 'snitch', 'grass', 'snake'.
- **Blame** themselves for what has happened rather than the person committing the crime
- **Negative** attitude of the police

anonymity promise:

- You can give us information about crime without giving any personal details.
- We will not make note of your gender or age.
- We will not record any personal details you might mention.
- We cannot trace your email or IP address.

What is county lines?

County lines is when criminal gangs set up a drug dealing operation in a place outside their usual operating area.

Gangs will move their drug dealing from big English cities to smaller towns across the UK in order to make more money.

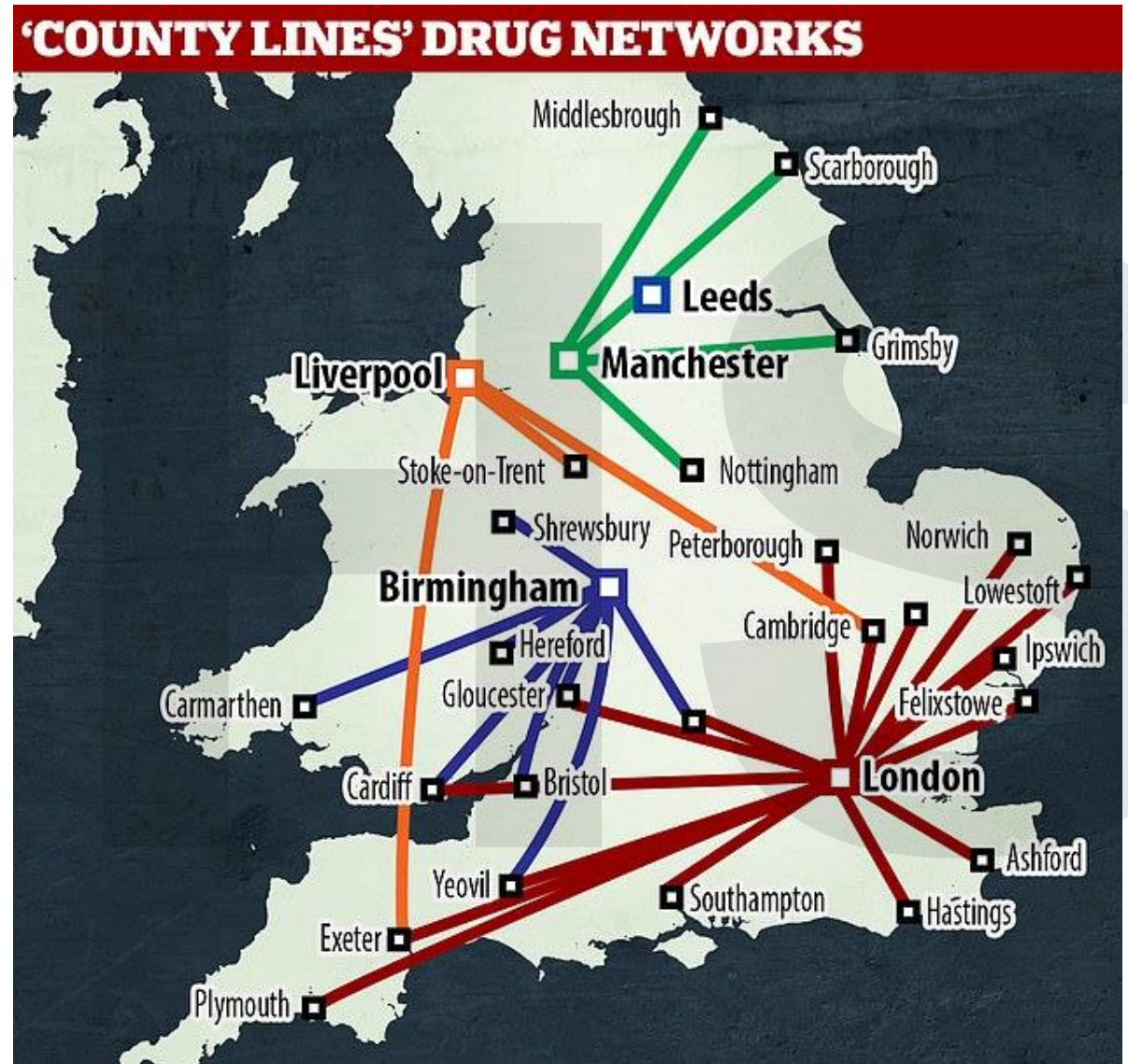

Fearless

- Criminal gangs moving drugs and money across the country from the city to other towns or rural areas
- They do this by getting young people ('mules') involved who they befriend and lure into their gang
- Once involved in the gang it is very difficult to get out.

Fearless

- 'Grooming' will take place and is a style of recruitment to get younger people to carry or deal drugs
- It starts with friendship, nice gifts, money, drugs, protection or favours. Then you owe the gang
- Now you will be forced to carry, or you and your family will be physically harmed
- You will be forced to carry 'burner phones', need to be available 24/7 and you are not allowed to miss any calls or messages
- You will be made to carry a weapon and there is a strong chance that other gangs will harm you



Fearless

- You will be manipulated into feeling wanted and that you will live a life of luxury
- Gang leaders will force you to stay in dangerous drug dens in another part of the country
- You will be bought a train ticket or taken to cities/towns a long way from your home
- You will be made to ingest drugs and 'carry' them inside your body to hide them from the police at great risk to your health
- You and your family will be threatened with excessive violence and harm if you do not carry out instructions
