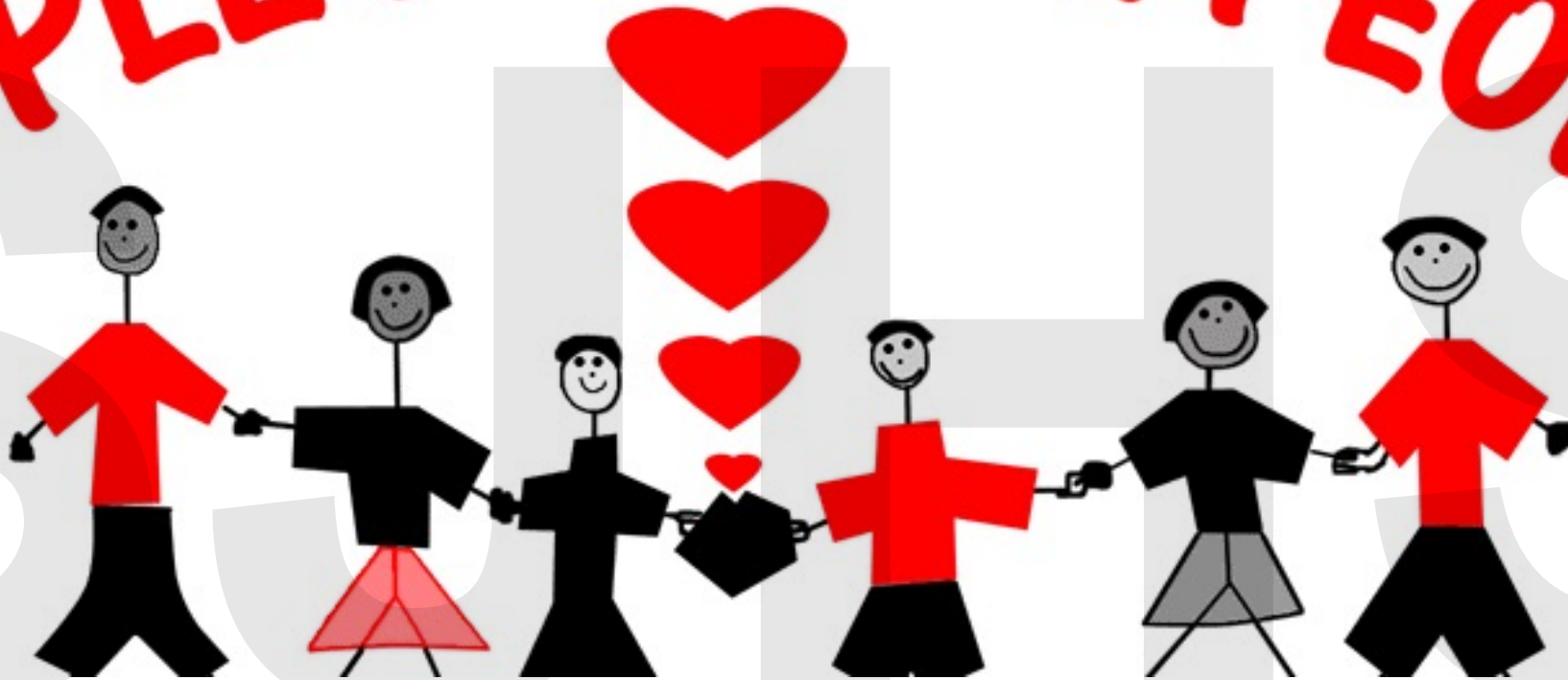

Many of you will have heard of the terrible event that happened recently during a European Championship football match between Denmark and Finland.

Highly experienced Danish footballer Christian Ericson collapsed after suffering a sudden cardiac arrest on the pitch.

Thankfully he is making a good recovery mainly due to the fantastic medical treatment he received on the pitch and in hospital, but also because of the quick thinking and actions of his loyal team mates.

CARDIAC ARREST VS HEART ATTACK

Both can kill. Both involve the heart. But they're not the same.



ARRHYTHMIA

WHAT IS CARDIAC ARREST?

CARDIAC ARREST OCCURS WHEN THE HEART MALFUNCTIONS AND STOPS BEATING UNEXPECTEDLY.

CARDIAC ARREST IS AN "ELECTRICAL" PROBLEM.



Cardiac arrest occurs when your heart's electrical signals go haywire – the heart stops beating and can't pump blood to the brain, lungs and other organs.



BLOCKAGE

WHAT IS A HEART ATTACK?

A HEART ATTACK OCCURS WHEN BLOOD FLOW TO THE HEART IS BLOCKED.

A HEART ATTACK IS A "CIRCULATION" PROBLEM.



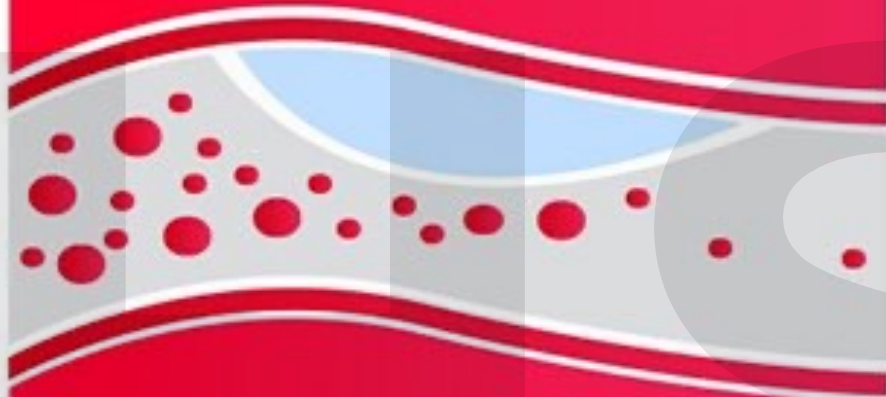
A blocked artery prevents oxygen-rich blood from reaching the heart. If the blockage isn't opened quickly, the blocked part of the heart begins to die.

CARDIAC ARREST is an
ELECTRICAL problem



The person will be
UNCONSCIOUS
Call 999 | Start CPR

A HEART ATTACK is a
CIRCULATION problem



The person will probably be
CONSCIOUS
Call 999 | Keep them calm

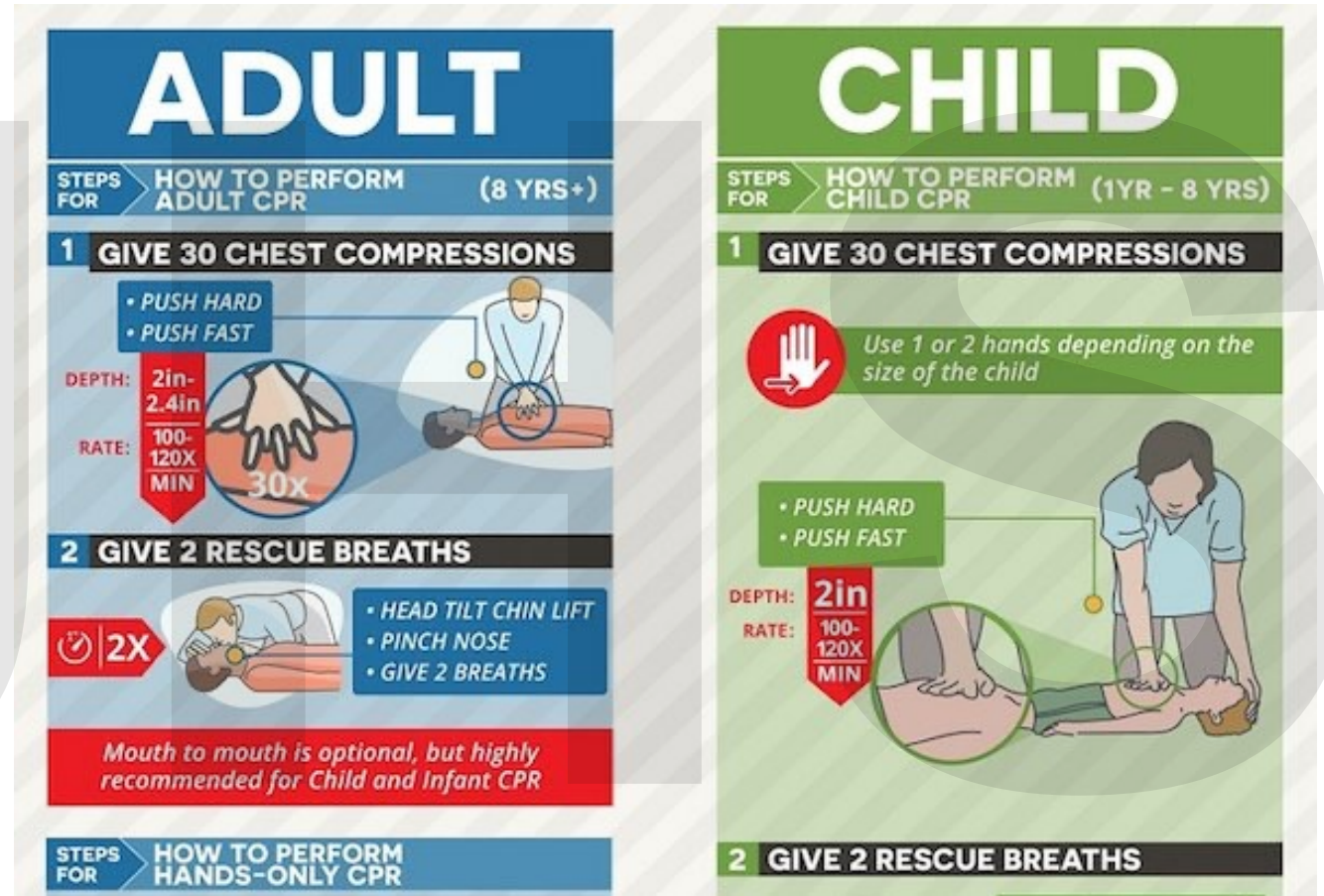
