AS Level

Unit 1 - The Nature of Law and the Welsh and English Legal Systems Written examination: 1 hour 45 minutes 25% of the qualification 60 marks

This unit requires learners to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the nature of law and the Welsh and English legal systems. They will also develop knowledge and understanding of the criminal justice system, civil justice system including relevant legal personnel and legal funding

Unit 2 - The Law of Tort

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes 15% of the qualification 60 marks

This unit requires learners to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the rules and theory of the law of tort. Learners will develop knowledge and understanding of liability in negligence for injury to people and will be required to apply the elements of the law of negligence to hypothetical scenarios.

Unit 3 : The Practice of Substantive Law

Written examination: 1 hour 45 minutes 30% of qualification 100 marks This unit requires learners to demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the two areas of law

- Criminal law.
